Increase number of signatures needed for constitutional amendments to make the ballot. Will increase to 6% of votes cast in Governor's race. Geographical Distribution of Signatures. 8% of signatures must be gathered in each congressional district	No geographical distribution requirement	No geographical distribution requirement
	Requires 2/3 vote of legislature to amend or repeal initiative provisions for 5 years.	Legislature can overturn/alter/change statutory amendments – no time restrictions
The legislature may hold additional public hearing on constitutional amendments-allowing public testimony prior to the fixing of the ballot title.	No legislative hearings	No legislative hearings
6 months to collect signatures	9 months to collect signatures	6 months to collect signatures for both statutory and constitutional amendments
